Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to letter of even No. dated 26/6/2009 regarding setting up of bank branches in unbanked blocks in the country and subsequent meeting on the subject held on 24/7/2009, the Minutes of which were circulated to all concerned.

This is to remind you that steps must be taken to ensure opening of a branch of Public Sector Bank (PSB) or RRB in the unbanked blocks of the States outside North Eastern Region by 31/12/2009.

For States falling in the North Eastern Region, similar steps must be taken to ensure opening of a branch of PSB or RRB by 31/3/2010. For NE States, the viablity Gap Funding Scheme of RBI may be effectively utilised by the Banks.

In areas where a brick and mortar branch can not be established immediately, the area must be made accessible to banking facilities through use of business correspondent model or other alternative techniques, as approved by the respective SLBC.
